

**Russell County Road Committee
Quarterly Meeting
March 14, 2016**

The Russell County Road Committee met on March 14, 2016. Those in attendance were: Magistrates Terry Waddell, Patrick Loy, Ronald Johnson, Steve Richardson and Larry Holt, Road Supervisor Jimmy McQueary, County Attorney Kevin Shearer and Deputy County Judge Executive Chris Ramsey.

Magistrate Holt presented the minutes from the December 14, 2015 meeting. Magistrate Waddell made the motion to approve the minutes. Magistrate Loy seconded. Motion carried.

Magistrate Holt opened the floor to discussion.
