

**RUSSELL COUNTY FISCAL COURT
CALLED MEETING
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2020
9:00 A.M.**


The Russell County Fiscal Court held a called meeting on Tuesday November 24, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. at the Russell County Courthouse. Those in attendance were Judge Pro-Tem Ronald Johnson, Magistrates Terry Waddell, Mickey Garner, Steve Richardson, Larry Holt, County Attorney Kevin Shearer and County Treasurer Kim Fenske.

HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL: Judge Pro-Tem Johnson called the meeting to order and stated the reason for the called meeting was to discuss the health insurance renewal for the fiscal court. He stated Mr. Kelly Harding was here from the KACo Benefits Group to present the plans they had to offer. He presented a detailed presentation of what the fiscal court currently has compared to two optional plans his group could administer. The jest of the comparison was a 26% increase for the current plan compared which has a deductible of \$1500.00 to the option 1 plan that was a 16.3% increase with a \$1000.00 deductible which is comparable to the current plan or the option 2 plan which is an HRA plan that came at a 14.8% increase with a net deductible of \$500.00.


Ms. Sharon Hill and Steven Hill of McKinney & Blair came before the court and provided their options to the fiscal court. Again, at the current plan the increase would be 26%. They then offered 3 options that had varying deductibles at increase in rates of 16.5% with a \$2000.00 deductible and 13.96% with a \$2500.00 deductible and 6.22% with a \$4000.00 deductible.

Judge Pro-Tem Johnson told both groups this was just an informational meeting and the fiscal court would review all the plans presented and make a decision at the December 14, 2020 meeting.

ADJOURN: Magistrate Waddell made a motion to adjourn with Magistrate Richardson seconding. All was in favor. The meeting adjourned at 10:37 a.m.
