

**RUSSELL COUNTY FISCAL COURT
CALLED MEETING
FRIDAY JUNE 25, 2021
9:00 A.M.**

The Russell County Fiscal Court held a called meeting on Thursday June 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the Russell County Courthouse. Those in attendance were County Judge Executive Gary D. Robertson, Magistrates Terry Waddell, Mickey Garner, Ronald Johnson, Steve Richardson, Larry Holt, Attorney Don Byrom, and County Treasurer Kim Fenske.

PAY BILLS: Judge Robertson stated there were some bills that needed to be paid out of this fiscal year and the bills were in the packet for the magistrates. Magistrate Garner made a motion to pay the bills with Magistrate Richardson seconding. The roll call was unanimous.


ACCEPT BID ON E-CIGS FOR DETENTION CENTER: Judge Robertson stated we needed to accept the bid for the E-Cigs for the Detention Center. Jailer Dunbar stated this was the only bid received and it was from Custom Technologies. The bid was for \$3.50 per unit for 1,000 units. Magistrate Garner made the motion to accept the bid with Magistrate Waddell seconding. The roll call was unanimous.

ACCEPT BID ON FOOD SERVICE FOR DETENTION CENTER: Judge Robertson stated we needed to accept the bid for food service for the Detention Center. He stated the bid was from the current vendor Kellwell Food Service. Jailer Dunbar stated the vendor had not imposed an increase for several years and recommended accepting the bid which was the only bid received. Magistrate Garner made a motion to accept the bid with Magistrate Richardson seconding. The roll call was unanimous.


ACCEPT BID ON SECURITY SYSTEM UPGRADE FOR DETENTION CENTER: Judge Robertson stated we needed to accept the bid for the security system upgrade for the Detention Center. He stated the bid was from Stanley Securities and this was also the only bid received. Jailer Dunbar stated the current system had been in use for 10 ½ years and had become archaic and outdated and could potentially put us in a liable position. He recommended we accept the bid. Magistrate Garner made a motion to accept the bid with Magistrate Johnson seconding. The roll call was unanimous.

RESOLUTION 21-07 AND MOA FOR CABIN FORK CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT: Judge Robertson stated we had received notification from the Department of Rural and Municipal Aid the Cabin Fork Creek Bridge project had been approved and before work could begin Resolution 21-07 needed to be passed so he could sign the MOA. Magistrate Garner made a motion to adopt Resolution 21-07 and sign the MOA with Magistrate Richardson seconding. The roll call was unanimous.

ADJOURN: Magistrate Richardson made a motion to adjourn with Magistrate Holt seconding. All was in favor. The meeting adjourned at 9:07 a.m.
